### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Overnight parking will be available. **NO PENS OR FEED** will be provided, so please come prepared.
2. **PeeWee** events will be on **Saturday** at 10:00 a.m.
3. **JR/JR** events will be on **Saturday**.
4. Contestants who enter in a **PeeWee** or **JR/JR (6-9)** event may not participate in any other event.
5. Admission is free. Food Concessions will be available both days.
6. **No phone-in, post entries or day requests** will be guaranteed.
7. There will be one full day of rodeo.  
**Call the Rodeo Secretary for any questions regarding this event between 7:00pm – 9:00pm any day before August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011.**

### RODEO RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Contestant age determined as of January 1, 2011. Proof of age may be required.
2. This is a NON Sanctioned rodeo, but will follow all of the same rules as in our past rodeos
3. All contestants must wear western hats, boots, and long sleeved shirts.
4. Contestant drug or alcohol use will result in automatic disqualification.
5. Numbers must be worn while competing.
6. No one is allowed in the arena or behind the chutes except contestants.
7. No refunds will be issued without a medical or veterinary certificate of proof.
8. All ties will be broken by the flip of a coin.
9. Any questions or problems must be addressed to the Arena Director by the contestant.
10. Entry form must be **complete, signed** by Parent/Guardian, and contain **entry fees**. *Incomplete entries result in a longer wait in the check-in line for everyone. Birth date & age are a must.*
11. **AWARDS: PAYBACK: 50%** minimum per event - 40/30/20/10 first through fourth except for bulls.  
Bull Riders payback will be 100% of the entry fees.  
No money Payback for PeeWee or JR/JR events.  
**BUCKLES to First Place** in Junior and Senior Events.  
The ten-point system will be used to determine the all-around awards. (Single Stake will count toward the all-around)  
**ALL-AROUND BUCKLES** to Junior, Senior and JR/JR winner..  
Scholarship awards will be given to the All-around Senior Boy and Girl.  
**POINTS** toward all events except Family Team Roping, JR JR & PeeWee.
12. **Rough stock Riders will be required to wear protective equipment (mouthpiece, vest, helmet/facemask).**
13. Riders should be ready to compete when name is called. Name will be called three times or be turned out.
14. **TEAM ROPERS:** are responsible for making sure partner submits their entry on time; otherwise you won't be entered.
15. **ALL DRAW OUTS ARE FINAL!**
- \*\* 16. **"FAT BABY" TYPE BOOTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE WORN IN THE ARENA DURING COMPETITION.**
